

Yorkshire Sun Society (YSS) is very proud of the fact that it is one of only a limited number of U.K. Naturist Clubs which allow the admission of dogs – in fact any pets.

Dogs in particular are admitted on the clear understanding that the dog(s) are the sole responsibility of the person or persons introducing them into the grounds, including responsibility for any damage or injury the dog(s) might cause. YSS requires its members who own dogs and bring them into the club's grounds to have Liability Insurance covering their dog ownership and requires the same thing as a pre-condition for visitors who wish to bring their dog.

Visitors might find they already have such Liability Insurance as part of their household contents insurance and/or pet insurance - it's worth a phone call to their insurers to find out. If not, we understand the Dogs Trust can help out, see [www.dogstrust.org.uk](http://www.dogstrust.org.uk) . Evidence of your Liability Insurance is required prior to a visit.

All dogs must be well behaved and in the care of considerate owners. All pet owners must clear up after their pets. Our woodlands abound with wildlife so all four-legged pets must be kept on a lead at all times whilst in the club grounds.

Pets are not allowed on our sun-bathing lawn, nor in the club house buildings or in the club static; that still leaves about 26 acres of woodlands to be explored.
